The Department of Education, Employment and Workplace Relations has recently announced that there is funding for people to complete Certificate II in Asset Maintenance – Carpet Cleaning and Certificate III in Asset Maintenance – Carpet Cleaning through the Productivity Places Program if they meet certain requirements. This is an exciting opportunity to get some formal Australian qualifications for your new staff.

Who is eligible for the Productivity Places Program?

You are eligible for a Productivity Places Program if you:

- Are currently unemployed
- Are an Australian citizen or permanent resident

What does the Productivity Places Program cover?

The Productivity Places Program covers:

Certificate II in Asset Maintenance – Carpet Cleaning which includes:

- Carpet Cleaning course
- Hands-On Stain Removal course
- Health and Safety course

OR

Certificate III in Asset Maintenance – Carpet Cleaning which includes:

Compulsory Units:

- Carpet Cleaning course
- Hands-On Stain Removal course
- Advanced Stain Removal course
- Health and Safety course

Elective Units covered are:

- Upholstery and Fabric Cleaning course
- Water Damage course
- Odour Control course

What other elective units can I do that are not covered in the funding?

Other elective units that you can select:

- Carpet Repairs and Reinstallation course – \$880.00
- Colour Repair and Restoration Course – \$880.00
- Leather Cleaning Course – \$550.00
- Fire and Smoke Restoration Course – \$550.00

There is a one off administration fee of \$100 payable to Jena Dyco. On completion of your training you will then receive a \$100 voucher for further Jena Dyco training.

AT THE END OF EACH COURSE THERE IS AN OPTIONAL IICRC EXAM TO SIT. THERE IS A FEE OF \$50 FOR EACH EXAM WHICH IS PAYABLE DIRECTLY TO IICRC (AT THE TIME OF THE EXAM) VIA CREDIT CARD.
